Dear Pastor & Church Family,

When we sent our last letter, we were packing up to hit the road. Since then, we have been busy, busy, busy and it has been a joy serving Jesus! We are just a bit late in sending out this recap of what's been going on and that's because we just got home yesterday. There is a lot to report and we're excited to fill you in!

APRIL

We left April 6 for Coaldale, Alberta. Gospel Light Baptist Church has been a tremendous blessing to our family and it is a privilege to make this yearly trip. Not only do we get to be involved in their spring revival, singing and preaching, but we get to interpret for their Deaf and also host a Deaf Day - there is always a blessing in spending time with these special people! We had a lady visit all the way from Medicine Hat because she saw the Deaf Day poster on Facebook. Bud had the opportunity that next Sunday to preach in voice and sign for the Deaf. Jenna was asked to give her testimony to the teen girls Sunday School class. **Please pray for Brian; he is a Deaf man in need of salvation.**

April 26 - we visited a church that is new to us! Airdrie Baptist Church has been meeting for five years now and we met Pastor Friesen in Coaldale a couple years ago. He asked Bud if we would be able to come present the Deaf ministry to the church and of course, we were more than happy to oblige!

They had also advertised that the Sunday services would be interpreted for Deaf and **James Slauenwhite, a Deaf man** who lives in Calgary, drove the thirty minutes for Sunday School and the morning service. This may seem like not a big deal, but for a Deaf man to drive that far to a brand new church, by himself, just to "check it out" was huge to us, not to mention the church family! We enjoyed meeting him and talking with him, and he really enjoyed Amy and Jenna interpreting the music for him, as well as seeing Bud preach with voice & ASL. They are serious about starting a Deaf ministry and we look forward to returning to teach ASL. James told us he knows more Deaf in Airdrie and is willing to connect us with them. **Please PRAY about this great opportunity with us!**

April 29 - our family had visited Maranatha Baptist Church several years ago and this Wednesday night found us in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario. We enjoyed the Bible Study and the next evening, we had supper with Pastor Jeremy Witte and his wife Jennifer. We joined them for their nursing home service and had a great time of fellowship with them.

MAY

May had us in a different church every Sunday!

May 3 - King James Bible Baptist Church (Gatineau, Quebec) We sang as a family and Bud preached. This is a young church with a great group of people and we enjoyed our time with them! We were able to talk about Deaf ministry with several of the members as well as the pastor.

May 8-10 - Bible Baptist Church (Cornwall, Ontario) We were asked to come for a three day revival meeting to sing and preach, as well as to talk to the

people about Deaf ministry. Bud is always more than happy to let people know what we do to reach the Deaf and the people showed interest in learning ASL and finding out if there are Deaf in the community.

May 17 - Liberty Baptist Church (Brockville, Ontario) Bud preached all three services and the family sang. There were first time visitors Sunday morning and evening. Again, there were many opportunities in talking with the pastor and the people about Deaf ministry. We met with one teenage girl who is interested in learning ASL. We were able to direct her to the Silent Word website for resources on learning ASL. We will be keeping in touch with her to see how she is doing! **Pray for Sylena**. Bud had an opportunity to pull out his chainsaw and help Pastor Dean DeLima with some trees in his backyard. Bud kept the pastor and his children busy hauling brush and piling wood as he cut. We're pretty sure that despite the aches later on, they were pleased with the result! Brother Dean's wife Stephanie kept us well fed; we appreciate the great meals and the fellowship!

May 24 - Metro Baptist Church of Toronto (Toronto, Ontario) The family sang and Bud preached the morning service, sharing our burden for Deaf. After a great lunch provided by the church people, we went back to the pastor's house and enjoyed a time of fellowship. Bud and Pastor Bianchi pulled out the guitars and we had a great time singing old songs of the faith. Mrs. Bianchi has signed off and on for years and was thrilled to ply Jenna with questions and helps in refreshing her ASL. There is a huge Deaf population in Toronto and they have met a few of them. Although none have visited the church, **we pray that God will open a door to reach them with the Gospel**.

May 31 - Cornerstone Baptist Church (Woodstock, Ontario) It's always a privilege to renew acquaintances. We had presented Deaf ministry to Pastor Guenther and his people several years ago and had an opportunity to do so again. Our family sang, Bud preached some in voice & sign. The people showed much interest in us coming back to teach ASL and possibly help them start a Deaf ministry in the church. We are excited about the opportunities God gives to share our burden and whatever knowledge we have.

JUNE

June 7-12 - Bible Baptist Church (Laval, Quebec) The 4th All Canadian Revival has been a blessing and this year was no different. We were privileged to sing and Bud preached once. It was a great time of refreshing and fellowship. Our trailer was full every morning (and most afternoons) with friends seeking a good cup of coffee. Good friends from Gatineau supplied the beans, and Jenna was happy to put her machine to work! Preachers from all over Canada came and some brought people with them. Several missionaries also joined us and we enjoyed praising the Lord together!

June 14 - July 3 - Evangelize New Brunswick (ENB). Two years ago, we had the great privilege of helping Bro. Mark Thren spread the Gospel via door hangers, Gospel pamphlets and open air meetings in Kings County, New Brunswick. We were excited to have three weeks this summer to help them once again, in and around the village of Gagetown, New Brunswick. It is a bit of a commute from where we parked the trailer in Quispamsis, but we spent our days in rural areas around Gagetown, putting out door hangers and talking to people working in their yards. We made several good contacts and one couple Bud talked to actually came to one of the open air meetings.
