Greetings from the North,

We are extremely grateful for the prayer of God's people! This past summer has been a whirlwind for our family, and yet the Lord protected us through it all.

While other Canadian communities witnessed the devastating effects of the wildfire season, God chose to spare Snow Lake. The landscape looks much different now. Although ice shacks, boats, and a few cabin properties were destroyed, everyone was relieved that we still had homes awaiting us. The second repatriation of the summer occurred on August 22nd, after 6 weeks of mandatory evacuation. We gripped the wheel tightly and sang "Showers of Blessings" as we hydroplaned through the pouring rain during the drive home.

Upon our return, our family hit the ground running. Unfortunately, our VBS had to be cancelled, but we found new opportunities to minister. We quickly assembled 150 thank you goodie bags containing chips, chocolate bars, and tracts for both international and domestic firefighters. Most of the Australians had completed their mission, but we personally thanked the Costa Rican and Canadian men and women for their efforts in protecting our town.

The church hosted a Welcome Home Community BBQ. We advertised that the first 120 people would receive a hotdog, pop, and chips. God supplied perfect weather, so we were all able to sit outside and fellowship with all of our guests. Nurses, first responders, and police officers joined us. David especially enjoyed flagging folks down on the road. Twenty-nine guests attended that evening, and the event also sparked conversation later with many others in town. Our goal was to spread the Gospel while showing gratefulness and kindness to those around. Every guest received a tract that night.

It has been extremely uplifting and encouraging to see many guests visit the church since the end of August. One of the travel nurses and her son moved to town recently, and they have been attending services. Another lady is facing many trials in her life and is seeking help.

A Christian neighbour and his wife are facing very challenging health issues. We were glad that he popped by for a visit a few days ago. His wife wants to come home, but she needs to stay in the hospital in Flin Flon for a while yet.

God has blessed us with so many unique opportunities to spread His Gospel this past summer. Hundreds and hundreds of tracts have been distributed all over Southern Manitoba and Northwestern Ontario. Even a flagman at a construction site received a tract hidden under a chocolate bar!

We certainly appreciate your prayers, support, and kindness as we continue to partner together in serving the Lord in Northern Manitoba!

Please pray for Crystal, a recovering addict; Denise's health & salvation; local & Costa Rican firefighters to read the tract & receive Christ, and results from the BBQ event.
